- Q1. Are Private Investigators and Private Investigative Agencies licensed?
A1. Yes by the State of Florida. It is a felony to practice without license. All P.I.'s must keep their "C" or "CC" investigative license with a licensed P.I. agency. Report unlicensed P.I.'s.

- Q3. Before you hire a private investigator what should you do or ask?
A3. Always confirm PI's state license. (Check State of Florida website.)

 - Confirm fees, retainers, expenses and special requirements in writing.
 - Ask for timely investigative reports.
 - Make sure investigator is prepared to testify in court (if required.)

Q4. How does a retainer work?

A4. The initial retainer averages between \$500 and \$1,500. A retainer guarantees the Private Investigator gets paid for services rendered. For instance, if the agreed retainer is \$500.00, the P.I. will keep track of hours and expenses, and will request additional retainer when \$500.00 of services has been performed. (MIHI Advisory reserves the right to waive the retainer for qualified clients.)

Q5. What fees are typical and that MIHI Advisory Group charges?

A5. Not all cases involve these fees, but a break down includes: investigative time, travel time, administrative time, mileage, and reimbursement for expenses, such as travel, lodging, rental vehicle, photographic processing, and record searches. MIHI Advisory Group accepts VISA and Mastercard.
